**SOP FOR STUDENTS IN CONNECTION WITH REOPENING OF CLASSES FROM 23.11.2020.**

1. Self-discipline is most important to minimize the spread of COVID-19 pandemic through Social Distancing and maintaining hygienic condition.
2. Student shall observe standard COVID-19 precautions like compulsorily undergoing Thermal Screening at the gate, wearing facemask, physical distancing of 2 meters (or 6 feet), frequent hand-washing with soap & water or use of hand sanitizer, follow cough etiquette, etc.
3. Students should provide Negative COVID Test Certificate and Declaration Certificate / Consent Form signed by the parents to attend Offline Classes.
4. Installation & use of Aarogya Setu App is mandatory.
5. Wearing ID card is mandatory in the campus.
6. Spitting and littering including discarding the disposable mask is strictly prohibited.
7. Students are advised not to be in groups in campus (Class Room, Laboratory, Library, Bank, Parking Lot, etc).
8. Right after the class, students are instructed to leave the campus through Gate no 2.
9. Students should follow the Guidelines, Advisories and Instructions issued by the Government authorities as well as by the University & College regarding health and safety measures in view of COVID-19 pandemic.
10. If attending Online classes, students may visit their respective department in small numbers for consultation with the faculty, after seeking prior appointment to avoid crowding and by maintaining physical distancing norms and other safety protocols.
11. Students should bring their food and drinking water from Home / Hostel and are advised not to share these with others.
12. Students should regularly sanitize their Mobile Phones, Laptops, Audio, Video and other Media Accessories.
13. Students should cooperate for any extended Class Hours.
14. While borrowing the books at Library, stand in the queue by maintaining social distance.
