Announcement of Course Work for Batch IV and other eligible Ph.D. Research Scholars

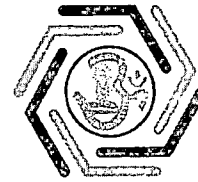
Research Scholars admitted to the Ph.D. program in the AY 2021-'22 (Batch-IV) shall require to complete the course work during the initial one year (within two semesters) from the date of registration.

Those Research scholars, who are willing to undertake course work examination in the current semester shall have to submit their application in the prescribed format together with relevant fee to the University **latest by 26th Feb. 2022.**

The offline course work examination will be held in the month of May 2022 as given below for all eligible Ph.D. Scholars:

NOTE: Candidates who have not taken the second attempt due to Covid pandemic in the previous exam held during Aug 16 – 19, 2021 (for Batch-III students) as well as other research scholars of previous years, subject to their eligibility are also permitted to take the current proposed exam as an exceptional case after paying the required exam fee (Rs. 1,500/- per each course) and valid proof.



Passing marks for the course work examination will be 55% in each course.
Research methodology is compulsory for all disciplines.

Syllabus for the exam will be as given below:

- (i) Paper- I Research Methodology (100 marks, 4 credits) –The topics under this course include:

Fundamental concepts of research, research ethics and good laboratory practice / methodology, advanced statistical methods for quantitative and qualitative research, computational techniques and applications.

- (ii) Paper-II Domain Specific Course (100 marks, 4 credits) –The topics under this course include:

Shall be in an advanced area(s) in the subject concerned in each discipline as approved by the BOS concerned for enabling the students to acquire deep knowledge in the preparation for PhD degree. Shall be prescribed by the concerned Research Supervisor.

- (iii) Paper –III Viva-Voce examination (100 marks, 4 credits) - The topics under this course include:

Quality of comprehensive literature review on the topic finalized for Ph.D. work, relevant to the specialization, critical analysis of literature and topic of research, relevance to the knowledge of learning or to a process, quality of written and oral presentation.
